**Dear Parents** 

I hope that you have had a wonderful summer. I held off as long as possible before providing clarity regarding back to school arrangements as I wanted to base them on the most current guidance available. I wish to acknowledge the co-operation shown by our parent body, the guidance and support of our Board of Governors and the dedication of our staff over the last year.

# Measures to Mitigate Risk

There are a number of measures that we are maintaining to ensure that we follow the DENI guidance and also ensure that any disruptions to learning are kept to an absolute minimum.

We will continue with staggered drop off and pick up times in line with guidance from DENI and to try and minimise large gatherings of parents/pupils at any one time on the school site. As has always been the case, the health and safety of our school community is a priority. These measures will be reviewed at Hallowe'en.

## School bags, lunch boxes, water bottles and pencil cases

Pupils can take these to school with them this year. Lunches will continue to be eaten in classrooms to avoid congestion in the dinner room.

## Required mitigations on return to School (Ref DE guidance)

We need to be assured of full compliance from parents with PHA guidance if a child is isolating either because of -

- A) Covid symptoms
- B) positive result
- C) close contact status or

D) having returned to Northern Ireland and isolating in line with NI Direct travel advice and regulations.

As above we would respectfully request that:

- Parents maintain 2 m distancing and are discouraged from gathering outside school grounds.
- As was the case last year no adults other than staff, or those with appointments will be admitted to the main school building. If a parent wishes to speak with any member of staff, including myself or Mrs. Kearney I would ask that you contact the main office on 02837523847 and an appointment or call back will be arranged
- Hand and Respiratory hygiene messages will continue to be shared with pupils.
- Ventilation of the school building will be managed carefully.

# Free School Meals / Uniform Allowance

Once again, we remind parents that application should be made online to EA for Free School Meals / Uniform Allowance. Even if you think your child will not avail of the free school meals, please make the application so you do not miss out on the Uniform Allowance. <u>School Meals will have to be paid for (or lunches taken) until approval is</u> <u>received from EA for the award of Free School Meals</u>. If you have applied for Free School Meals but have not received your approval letter please pay for any meals on the School Money Website/App. The Free School Meal Numbers also have an impact on the budget our school receives.

In relation to the **annual flu vaccination** due in November, letters from the Health Service will be sent home prior to this date for parents to complete and return.

## Primary 1 Intake 2021

We would like to welcome our new P1s. They will be coming in for staggered induction for 1 day only between Friday  $27^{\text{th}}$  and Friday  $3^{\text{rd}}$  from 9 - 11 am. Children should bring water and fruit for morning snack. They can be dropped off and picked up from the side door of the school building. All P1 children will attend from 9 - 11 am from Monday  $6^{\text{th}}$  to Friday  $10^{\text{th}}$  September. Children will be in from 9 - 12 noon week beginning  $13^{\text{th}} - 17^{\text{th}}$  and from  $20^{\text{th}}$  September will be in for a full day 9 am - 2 pm. From Monday  $6^{\text{th}}$  there will be staggered start and finishing times which will be communicated at a later date.
